• **Goodbye** [unlike Spanish, it's never used for greetings]

• Bye (bye) [often heard twice]

• Cheerio [British English]

See you

• See you soon / tomorrow / on Monday / next week...

• Fare you well [literary or poetic]

• **So long** [rather literary]

• Good day [Australian English]

• **Keep in touch** [very frequent in informal letters & emails]

• I'll put the kettle on [very British; most likely on the phone]

• **Good night** [Never use it to say 'hello'!]

• **Sleep tight** [often combined with the one above]

• I'm off [you say that when you're about to leave]

• I'll be right back [you announce that it won't take you long

to come back]]

• Take it easy

• Have a nice weekend!

• Have a good trip/journey.

• Don't call us, we'll call you [after an unsuccessful job interview]

• (I shall be) looking forward to seeing you. [formal letters]

• (I'll be) looking forward to your news. [letters]
