**AT - ON - IN**

**AT** + ...

CLOCK TIME ... **at** 7.00pm / noon / midnight / the same time...

SPECIAL HOLIDAY PERIODS / FESTIVALS ...

**at** Christmas / Easter / Carnival...

WEEKENDS ...

**at** the weekend ...

THIS/THAT MOMENT ...

**at** the moment...

NIGHT TIME ...

**at** night.

**ON** + ...

A PARTICULAR DAY ...

**on** Monday / Saturday / holiday...

**on** October 12th / your birthday...

**on** Christmas Day / New Year's Eve...

PART OF A PARTICULAR DAY ...

**on** a Sunday morning / Friday evening...

WEEKEND (American English!)

**on** *the weekend* (AmE)

**IN** + ...

PARTS OF A DAY ...

**in** the morning / afternoon / evening;

LONGER PERIODS:

- Months ...

**in** December / January...

- Seasons ...

**in** spring/summer/autumn/winter;

- Years ...

**in** 1995 / 2020...

- Decades ...

**in** the 50s / sixties...

- Centuries ...

**in** the 21st Century...

- Other time expressions:

**in** the Middle Ages...

**in** the past / future / meantime...

**in** two hours/days/weeks/months/years...
