Compound words

a) First element adjectival, stress on second element.

First element nominal. b) stress on first element.

- Disyllabic words & verbs of Latin origin

Verbs of this sort are typically accented on the root while the corresponding nouns (or adjectives) are accented on the prefix; eq.: abstract, conduct, conflict, contrast, convert, convict, desert, perfect, permit, present, produce, project, subject...

> • There are *notable exceptions* though: control, direct, patrol, reform, release, report, request, return... Other words are always stressed on the first syllable regardless of their function: boycott, comfort, process, welcome...
